

COVID-19 At Davidson's Countryside Campground

Our guidelines are updated weekly as the situation is very fluid. Please be sure to check our guidelines prior to your stay with us to be up-to-date on any changes that may occur. We appreciate your understanding and patience during these very uncertain times. We will be actively adjusting our guidelines as we are updated per CDC and NH.gov.

General Guidelines and Updates:

- We are currently accepting reservations for Tent, RV, and Cabin Rentals. Sites and Cabins will be cleaned per CDC guidelines after each stay.
- The individual who is checking in will be asked if anyone in his or her party is sick or not feeling well based on the screening guidance outlined in the Universal Guidelines for All New Hampshire. If so, the Campground must refuse service to the entire party and provide a refund in accordance with Campground policies.
- Guests must agree to the following guidelines in our PRE-CHECK-IN form before arriving:
 - Each person in your party who is 2 years of age and older will have a 2-ply face covering available at all times.
 - When in contact with someone outside of your household or in the Office/Rec Hall/Restrooms, you will need to wear your mask.
 - Everyone in your party has read and understands our COVID-19 guidelines posted on our Website.
 - You agree that everyone in your party has read and understands our current Campground rules and regulations.
 - You agree you agree that before arriving in New Hampshire, everyone in your party has only gone out for essential items and when outside of the home maintaining social distancing and wearing face masks when within less than 6 feet of another person
 - In the last 14 days, no one in your party has been feeling ill with CDC symptoms of COVID-19.
- Each vehicle will be required to place a refundable \$20 **cash only** deposit on a Gate Card to allow access through our Security Gate. Your deposit will not be refunded if the Gate Card is lost, stolen, or not returned in working order. Gate Cards will be limited to one per vehicle. You will be responsible for using the Gate Card to enter the Campground.
- We will be adding proper signage at all facilities as a reminder of the guidelines.
- We are implementing the 6-foot social distancing rule when you are off your site.
- We are limited reservations to one household per site, that does not exceed the limitations below:
 - We are limiting gatherings to no more than 10 people per site at one given time.
 - There will be a maximum of 3 adults per reserved site at this time.
- All customers ages 2 and older must have a 2-ply face mask **with you** when you are off your site. This means when you are within the 6-foot distance of another person, please put on your mask. You will need a mask when you are in the Store, Rec Hall and Restrooms.
- Security Officers will be patrolling and implementing a limited contact approach. **We will have our Security Officers speak with you only one time before asking you to leave. We have had an increase in complaints due to the fact people are not being respectful. We will not continue to put our staff in harm's way if you choose to not obey the Campground rules. You may be asked to leave should we have complaints.**
- If at any point you refuse to follow these guidelines, you will be asked to leave immediately with no refunds.
- All Non-refundable reservation policies will be implemented. Should you have an emergency prior to your stay that we deem as an exception, we may offer a credit toward a future stay.

MASK WEARING:

YOU HAVE TO HAVE A MASK ON YOUR PERSON AT ALL TIMES WHEN YOU ARE OFF YOUR SITE.

1. Masks are required to be worn in the following way:
 - a. When in the Rec Hall, Office area, Store, and Restrooms.
 - b. When you are within 6 feet of a NON-HOUSEHOLD member.
 - c. When you are visiting another person's site and are within 6 feet of others.
2. You do not need to have your mask covering your nose and mouth:
 - a. When you are on your site or in your trailer with your household members.
 - b. When you are walking around in the Campground with your household members.
 - c. When you are swimming in the pool or at the beach with your household members.

VISITORS: Visitor fees still apply. Daily \$5 per adult; Nightly \$10 per adult.

1. All guests ages 18 and over will be required to fill out a **Pre-Check-In form prior to entering** the Campground. There is a Pre-Check-In link on our Website that they MUST fill out, and they MUST press "Submit" so that it will be sent right to our email. If your guests are unable to complete the form online, they may call us; and we will provide a paper copy for them to fill out when they arrive. If your guest is arriving in your vehicle, please write that in the Additional Questions or Services Box at the bottom of the submission form. No car tag will be needed.
2. Visitors entering the Campground without registering with the Office prior, will be asked to leave immediately. If you are found letting in unregistered guest(s), you will be asked to leave with no refunds.
3. There will be a maximum of 3 overnight adults per site.
4. All guests are to schedule their visits ahead of time. With all the new guidelines and paperwork we now have to complete, please allow at least 24 hours' notice to the Office so that we can complete this paperwork prior to their visit. If guests are last-minute, it will take longer to complete this process.
5. After-hours guests can be provided with a packet on our Office door with proper tags, completed paperwork, payment and when prior authorization is scheduled ahead of time. No check-ins after 7:00 p.m.
6. There is a maximum of 10 people gathering on each site. Social distancing and mask guidelines are in place for when you are within 6 feet of NON-HOUSEHOLD members.

Amenities

POOL: Open 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

1. There will be NO CHAIRS provided by us in the pool area. You may bring your own chair to sit in. When are you done swimming, all items, including chairs, are to be removed. Do not leave your chairs at the pool when you leave.
2. You will need to practice social distancing by staying 6 feet away from people who are not in your household.
3. You will not be required to wear a mask in the pool area or while swimming.
4. **Maximum of 12 people (including children) in the pool and pool area at one time.** If the pool area is at capacity, you will have to come back at another time. Please be courteous and allow others to use the pool that has been waiting.

5. If, at any time, anyone is not following these guidelines and/or we have a complaint, you may be asked to leave the pool area for the rest of the day.

PLAYGROUND: 8:00 a.m. to Dusk

1. Adults are responsible for their children while they are on the playground area. Example: A child gets hurt while playing, an adult needs to be readily available for assistance.
2. If a child is not feeling well or has signs of sickness, you are responsible for keeping them at home.
3. We will not be disinfecting playground equipment after every use. You will be responsible for practicing proper hygiene care before and after children use the facilities. Examples are: Washing hands before and after using the playground with warm soapy water for at least 60 seconds and Covering all coughs and sneezes properly.
4. All children need to return to their sites when the sun goes down.

STORE and REC HALL: Hours posted on our Website

1. Rec Hall and Store will be open for the limited hours posted on our Website.
2. Limit of 10 people with at least 6 feet of distance maintained between people at all times.
3. Facial coverings will be required.
4. Games and tables are open to play with. We do ask for you to let Staff members know when you are finished so they may clean them.
5. We will be offering curbside and delivery upon request.

OFFICE: Hours posted on our Website

1. Office will be implementing Pre-Check-In on our website prior to your stay. You will need to finalize your reservation by submitting this form prior to your check-in. This will include all current guidelines and amenities. There will be instructions for how to pay any balance on your site.
2. Once you confirm your reservation it is NON-REFUNDABLE. You are responsible to paying for all balances upon arrival.

Restrooms - OPEN

1. Restrooms will be open and are limited to those who are not self-contained.
2. If you have a sewer on your site, please use your own facilities.
3. We will be frequently cleaning restrooms per DHHS's Guidelines.
4. Do not overcrowd the restrooms.
5. Masks are required when not doing normal routines.
6. Quarters are needed for our showers. The Office can provide change during our open Hours.

Activities

1. Activities will follow social distancing guidelines of least 6 feet of distance maintained between people at all times.
2. Facial coverings will be required to and from the hall.
3. Please check the calendar for the most up-to-date activities.
