COVID-19:

With the uncertainty how the COVID-19 virus will affect our camping experience, we will be practicing all CDC and local government guidelines. We ask that before your planned camping trip, please check this to see what the guidelines will be. Activities will also be changed to form these guidelines. Those who choose not to respect these guidelines will be asked to leave with no refund.

OFFICE HOURS:

QUIET HOURS: All the time. Please respect your neighbors at all times of the day. We are a family-oriented Campground. Therefore, loud music, foul language, and partying are not permitted.

Please let us know immediately if you are being disturbed by others so that we can address the situation. To confidentially report excessive after-hours noise, please call or text 603-455-4335 while it's happening. We cannot work on solving the problem if you tell us the next day.

We have Security Officers who make the rounds to help enforce this policy. If you and/or yours are considered to be making excessive noise, you will receive <u>ONE</u> verbal warning during your stay. If we have to speak with you and/or your party more than once during the duration of your stay, you may be asked to leave immediately. All warnings are reported to the Owners.

CAR TAG USAGE: When you Check-In, you will be given a Car Tag. This tag proves that you have registered as a guest. It **MUST** hang from your rearview mirror **AT ALL TIMES** when approaching the Office and within the Campground. You may remove the Car Tag while you are driving outside of the Campground. But, if you have taken it off, be sure to pull off to the side of Schofield Road to hang it back up **BEFORE** approaching the Office and Security Gate.

Please keep the Car Tag <u>WITH YOUR VEHICLE</u>. <u>If the tag is not visible to the Office Staff, we will not open the Security Gate</u>. You will need to park the car and come into the Office to verify your guest registration.

GATE CARD USAGE: Due to COVID-19, each vehicle will need a Gate Card to gain access to the Campground. A \$20.00 CASH ONLY deposit is needed to obtain a Gate Card. The Office will only open the Gate for Registered DAY guests, displaying a paid tag hanging from their rear-view mirror.

When using the Gate Card, please drive at least 6 inches away from the white meter box, and gently wave it.

When leaving the Campground please pull up to the gate, it will automatically open. It is refundable, when the card is returned in working condition to the Office upon check-out.

SECURITY GATE:

24 hour Access:

- A previously-obtained Gate Card is needed at all times to allow access.
- If you do not have a Gate Card, park your car in the Parking Area on the right side of the Office and walk in to your Campsite. Please leave your Car Tag hanging from the rearview mirror while your car is parked outside of the Gate.

VISITORS: DUE TO COVID-19 ALL VISITORS ENTERING THE CAMPGROUND MUST COMPLETE THE PRE-CHECK IN FORM ON OUR WEBSITE.

- IF ANYONE ENTERS THE CAMPGROUND WITHOUT COMPLETING THIS FORM ALL PARTIES WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE IMMEDIATELY.
- Currently there is a maximum of no more than 3 adults and 3 children per site, pending size of site, for overnight guests.
- There is a maximum of 10 people gathering on a site at any given time due to COVID-19.

PETS: Pets are allowed in our Campground, but our rules **MUST** be followed. While we do not discriminate against any breed of dogs, dogs that are uncomfortable with lots of people, children, and other dogs should be kept home. Unfortunately, if your dog is involved in any type of altercation with a human or another animal, you will be asked to seek an alternative placement for your dog for the duration of your stay.

- All dogs must be on a leash <u>at all times, even on your</u> site.
- Clean up after your dogs. Waste bags are located at the Dog Walk Area near the flagpole. Do not bury dog waste.
- Do **not** leave your dogs unattended at your Campsite.
- Do not allow your dog to bother others with constant barking.
- DOGS ARE **NOT** ALLOWED ON THE BEACH, THE BEACH GRASSY AREA OR WITH-IN THE GATED POOL AREA WHERE PEOPLE SWIM.
- Doggie Dips are allowed at the Boat Launch only.
- Non-aggressive dogs are welcome.

<u>CAMPGROUND SWIMMING POOL</u>: Please see website for updated hours and operations during COVID-19. Open daily from 10:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. Weather permitting. <u>Swim at your own risk</u>.

- Pool is open to Registered Guests only.
- After checking out of the Campground, you are no longer considered a Registered Guest and cannot use the pool.
- Please shower off prior to entering the pool. Shower is located inside the pool area on the fence closest to the road.
- Children (ages 17 and under) must be accompanied by an adult (age 18+) at all times.
- Small children in diapers MUST wear water-approved diapers.
- Pool floats, balls, noodles, and dive sticks are allowed in the pool.
- NO DIVING or JUMPING into the pool.
- Only WATER in a PLASTIC BOTTLE is allowed in the Pool Area.
- Pets are NOT allowed in the Pool Area.
- SMOKING & food products are NOT allowed in the Pool Area.

Should a person get injured or become ill in the pool or pool area, notify Staff immediately.

RESTROOMS:

- Our Restrooms are open 24 hours a day.
- The facilities include: modern toilets, sinks, and coin-operated showers.
- Our showers take US quarters only. \$0.50 will get you a 6 minute shower. An additional quarter will give you an
 extra 3 Minutes. \$0.75 is the maximum amount of money the shower will accept. When taking your shower,
 please add your quarters quickly one after another. Do not wait in between quarters, as the machine will time out.
- Quarters are available at our Office only during our current Office hours.
- If at any time, our Restrooms need assistance, please give the Office a call during the Office hours.

<u>DUMPSTER AREA</u>: All Campground visitors are required to clean up trash from their Campsites before they leave. Since our disposal company separates the trash for recycling, all household trash, including normal recyclables, can be thrown into the dumpster located diagonally across from the Office.

Items we do not accept for disposal: You will have to take them home.

Chairs - Appliances - Large batteries - Grills -Furniture
 Metals and frames - Construction debris - Wood - Plastic chairs - Paints and stains

GOLF CARTS: Electric golf carts are allowed; insurance is needed. You can rent them from a local dealer. You will need to sign our Golf Cart Rules upon Check-In. Please contact the Office for more information.

FIREWOOD: Per New Hampshire state law, <u>out-of-state wood is NOT allowed</u> into New Hampshire.

Wood is available for purchase at the Office/Store.

Wood is typically delivered within an hour of ordering. During holiday weekends, this delivery time can increase due to high volume.

Wood deliveries are only available until 6:45 p.m. Please place your order by 5:45 p.m.

On Holiday Weekends, we suggest that you pre-order wood as soon as you can. You can do this by calling the Office.

GENERAL RESTRICTIONS:

- Drones are NOT allowed in the Campground.
- ATV/dirt bikes are NOT allowed in the Campground.
- Fireworks are NOT allowed in the Campground.
- The only items permitted to be burned in fire pits are: untreated wood, paper, fire starters. NO TRASH.
- Fire pit is not allowed to be moved from its current location, but rearranging rocks for cooking is permitted.
- Coals and leftover burnt wood can remain in the fire pit. We will dispose of this after you leave.
- Please do not cut down any of our trees. Foraging for wood that is on the ground is permitted.
- For a more detailed list, please see the back side of our map.

EMERGENCY: Call 911 and then call 603-455-4335 so that Staff can guide Emergency Personnel to your Campsite.

<u>CHECK-OUT PROCEDURE</u>: 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. -- <u>Please Check Out at the Office & Return Car Tag/Gate Card</u>

- Late Check-Out time may be arranged with the Office before your scheduled Check-Out time.
 - After 12:00 p.m.: Additional charge (not always available)
- Please put out all fires with water & return any tables that were removed from your Campsite.
- Bring all trash to the Dumpster Area.
- When checking out, you must exit the security gate and then return the Gate Card to the Office.
- After checking out, you cannot re-enter the Campground to use the facilities.
